## **Introduction**

In May of 2001, a conference of ministers responsible for youth affairs in the Barents region was held in Tromsø, Norway. At the conference, a Plan of Action for the future Barents cooperation in the youth field was adopted. In this Plan it was stated that mechanisms for information and guidance for youth groups in the Barents region would be established. The Barents Euro-Arctic Working Group on Youth Policy is responsible for the implementation of the Plan of Action. As a result of this, the Barents Youth Cooperation Office was established in Murmansk, Russia.

The overall objective for the establishment of such a service is:

- A well functioning multilateral cooperation in the youth field, that contributes to an improved situation for young people in the Barents Region, as well as a sustainable development of the region.

Coordinators for youth cooperation in the Barents Euro-Arctic Region are appointed by the Barents Euro-Arctic Working Group on Youth Policy. These coordinators shall provide information and guidance for youth groups, organisations and networks on:

- national and international resources for funding of projects
- education in project planning, implementation and follow-up
- possible cooperation partners nationally and internationally
- planned and ongoing youth projects and meetings in the Barents Region

The coordinator shall also stay in close and regular contact with the regional and local administrations in the Barents Region and with other cooperation structures and organisations working with youth issues in the northern part of Europe.

## **Work in 2008**

During the report period the Office has provided support to 28 international youth projects in such spheres as culture, youth entrepreneurship, education, environment, indigenous issues, sport, youth NGO and youth policy. 21 projects were successfully completed, and 7 projects were cancelled or postponed. Among the biggest projects to be mentioned are Barents Youth Seminar 2007 “Youth in the Barents region lottery win or a bad luck?”, Young Entrepreneurs of the Barents Region, Murmansk 2016, etc. More detailed information about these projects can be found in the attachment 3 to the Report.

Following the priorities of the Finnish Chairmanship in 2007 BYCO was involved in the organization of the Part II of the seminar "Youth in the Barents Region - a lottery win or bad luck?". The aim of the seminar was to examine the situation of young people in the Barents Region from different perspectives. BYCO was also cooperation this Russian authorities concerning the preparation of the coming Russian Chairmanship.

The office also supports the work of Barents Regional Youth Council, working in constant contact with the members of the council and Norwegian Barents Secretariat. Barents Regional Youth Council is a council consisting of 14 youth representatives (1 from each region + 1 indigenous representative), was created 2004. The tasks of the council are: to strengthen the youth cooperation in the Barents region, to influence regional authorities in questions concerning youths and their future in the Barents region, to empower young people to actively participate in the shaping of the Barents region and the society in which they live. The Council meets twice a year to exchange information about youth news from the regions and to discuss their activities. A training course for the members of the BRYC is normally held in connection with the meeting to give the members necessary skills for their work.

One of the main functions of BYCO is to facilitate cooperation between the regions, so it functions as a link between youth authorities of different regions,

facilitating contacts between them. For example, BYCO is involved in cooperation and negotiations between youth authorities of Murmansk region and Lapland.

The expertise gained by BYCO is acknowledged and widely used by other actors. The office staff has been invited as an expert to the grant committee of the Murmansk regional board for youth affairs where the best projects were chosen and financed.

In 2007 BYCO was took part in the Consultative seminar on cooperation between the Russian Federation, the Council of Europe and the European Union, where the perspectives for youth cooperation were discussed. And youth cooperation in the Barents Region was mentioned among the most successful examples of such cooperation.

As it concerns cooperation with other international bodies, BYCO is cooperating with the Baltic Youth Secretariat on Youth Affairs. There is an interlinkage on the websites of these 2 organizations and news exchange.

BYCO staff was participating in the meeting of the Baltic Youth Forum in St.Petersburg as an observer. The main aim of the meeting was to find new ways for development of Baltic Youth Cooperation, and Barents Youth Cooperation was mentioned as a positive example. New contacts with the representatives of youth councils established there will be very useful in future work.

Another important issue in 2007 was the evaluation of the WGYP and BYCO activities. Dr Julia Zubok from the Institute for Socio-Political Research at the Russian Academy of Sciences was assigned by the WGYP to conduct an evaluation of WGYP and BYCO activities. BYCO was assisting Mrs. Zubok in the planning of her survey, finding experts, proving information and counselling support. The aim of the evaluation was to provide elements that could be taken into account by the subsequent Chairmanships in the preparation of its programmes and thus strengthening a continuity between chairmanships.

The office provides information and counseling for youth groups concerning project management, finding opportunities, partner search abroad. In

some projects it is even involved in such practical matters as visas, hotel and conference arrangements, and transportation.

Counseling concerning studies abroad and possibilities for getting stipends and grants for long term studies or short summer courses provided by BYCO is also in great demand by the youths and their parents. The office also gets a lot of enquiries about possibilities to go on a traineeship or voluntary service to the Nordic countries or Europe.

Office staff is often invited to regional youth forums where BYCO provides the information about cooperation possibilities, but also creates a wider contact network of youth organizations. Office representative travels around the Barents region, meeting both youth authorities and youth organizations, spreading the information about cooperation and funding possibilities and encouraging them to international cooperation.

Besides project support the daily work of the Office includes maintenance of the web-site [www.byco.ru](http://www.byco.ru), where the news from the regions and various youth projects as well as information about coming projects is published. One can also find there useful information about project finding and links to funding organizations and youth organizations of the Barents region. The booklet containing updated information about project funding, exchange opportunities and advice on project management is planned to be published later this year.

## Projects supported by BYCO

### Report 2007

#### I. Completed projects

##### **01/2007 “Verges” international theatre festival**

**Objective:** to develop and advertise youth theatre as a way of expression and self realization, expand the repertoire of the youth theatre groups, improve the quality of their performance and pay special attention to talented amateur groups

**Sphere:** youth culture

**Description:** An international festival of youth theatre groups. During the festival experience exchange between youth theatre groups from Murmansk region, other regions of Russian Federation & other countries, their directors, tutors of music, acting and speech, took place. They attracted a lot of attention of critics, mass-media and authorities to youth amateur theatre. There were awards in the following nominations: the best performance, the best actor, the best actress, the best musical accompaniment, the best screenplay, the original stage and setting design and the best ensemble of actors.

**Place and date:** Murmansk, 15-18 February 2007

**Participants:** Russia + Finland = around 50 participants + audience

**Organizer:** Murmansk Regional Board for Youth Affairs

**Financing:** Murmansk Regional Board for Youth Affairs, contributions of the participants

Norwegian Barents Secretariat

**BYCO’s involvement:** small: counseling, spreading the information about the event to the possible project partners.

**Duration of support:** December 2006– February 2007.

**Result:** After positive experience of Verges 2007 it was decided to make it an international annual youth theater festival. The applications for Verges 2008 will be received from September to December 2007.

##### **02/2007 Young Entrepreneurs in the Barents region.**

**Objective:** to improve youth entrepreneurship in the Barents, to increase knowledge of international business, to give young entrepreneurs special education and contacts

**Sphere:** young entrepreneurship

**Description:** The project aim is increase the knowledge about and experience of international entrepreneurial collaboration in the younger generation through specific education, as well as to establish a network across the national borders. The network should lead to the development of work opportunities and new and

innovative projects, which together will give increased growth within the Barents Region.

The primary aim of the project is to give young entrepreneurs increased opportunities for international business development. This is to be achieved through strengthening contacts between young entrepreneurs and businessmen, and improving knowledge of cultural differences within the Barents Region. First conference of the project was held in Finland. The participants got to know each other through speed-dating, there were arranged some presentations and workshops on such topics as creativity in business solutions, marketing and attracting customers.

Second conference was held in Sommaroy (Norway), the ideas from the first conference were developed there.

The work of the project was continued via web-based conferences and workshops.

**BYCO's involvement:** medium: counseling, participation in the meetings of the steering group of the project, assistance in practical arrangements, counseling of the YE coordinator and project participants.

**Duration of support:** February 2005 – present time.

**Result:** 2 conferences have been held. The participants meet in web conferences and lectures between the physical meetings. The work goes on. Next event will take place in October in Murmansk.

**03/2007 Murmansk 2016 – Capital of the Arctic *new!***

**Objective:** to investigate and to propose some ideas of making Murmansk a better place to live – to make it the capital of the Arctic by 2016.

**Sphere:** culture

**Description:** a seminar where youths led by professional architects explored possibilities and made concrete suggestions on how to make Murmansk a better place, suggestions included renovating the old houses, taking care of the harbor area, making some pedestrian streets and opening more cafes.

**Place and date:**

**1 seminar:** Murmansk, 5-7 February 2007

**2 conference:** Murmansk, 10-13 June 2007

**Participants:** Russia + Norway = 30 participants, (60 participants – conference)

**Organizer:** Innovation circle group, Murmansk Regional Board for Youth Affairs

**Financing:** EU (through Innovation Circle), Norwegian Barents Secretariat-2000 euro

**BYCO's involvement:** small: counseling, spreading the information about the event, participation in the event.

**Duration of support:** February 2007.

**Result:** a lot of ideas on making Murmansk a better place were generated by the participants during the seminar, suggestions from the conference have been given to the Murmansk city administration and the Committee of city planning.

#### **04/2007 Breaking Stereotypes** *new!*

**Objective:** The main goal of the project was to create conditions for a common informational space where people from two countries could get a true and objective information about each other, not based on false stereotypes and further spreading of this informational space.

**Sphere:** culture (mass media)

**Description:**

During the seminar the participants discussed the problem of stereotypes and have determined the following topics for future work: 1. The basics of Norwegian economy. 2. Immigrants and inborn Norwegians. 3. Feminism among Norwegian women. 4. System of secondary education in Norway and Russia. 5. Food traditions in Norway and Russia. 6. Attitude to sexual minorities.

7. Freedom of speech in Russia. 8. Criminalization of business in Russia. 9.

Traditions of alcohol consumption. 10. Peculiarities of business in Norway.

**Place and date:** February 17, 2007 Murmansk, 25 April 2007.

**Participants:** Russia + Norway = 30 participants

**Organizer:** Innovation circle group, Murmansk Regional Board for Youth Affairs

**Financing:** EU (through Innovation Circle), Norwegian Barents Secretariat

**BYCO's involvement:** small: counseling, spreading the information about the event, participation in the event.

**Duration of support:** February 2007.

**Result:** It is planned to continue discussion of the stereotype problem on the forums of partner sites of the project. According to the results of the discussion there will be formed a final list of topics.

### **05/2007 Yukigassen sports festival**

**Objective:** to establish stronger contacts between the youth of Vardø and Murmansk, to promote healthy life style and the spirit of the fair play.

**Sphere:** culture and sport

**Description:** Yukigassen is a traditional Japanese snowball fight, very popular in Northern Norway and Finland. Russian participants were invited for the first time. The programme of the festival also included some cultural performances and events.

**Place and date:** Murmansk 20-21 February , Vardo 20-25 March., Murmansk 25 April 2007.

**Participants:** Norway (10) (40) Russia (200)(10) Finland (10)

**Organizer:** Municipality of Vardø, Youth committee of Murmansk

**Financing:** Barents Secretariat, own financing of the organizers.

**BYCO's involvement:** medium: counseling, practical assistance, coordination of activities

**Duration of support:** February – April 2007

**Result:** the project was carried out. It is planned to continue cooperation next winter.

### **06/2007 Media training course for BRYC**

**Objective:** to strengthen the cooperation between youth organisations in the Barents region.

To give the BRYCers some necessary skills in media work.

**Sphere:** NGOs cooperation

**Description:** A council consisting of 14 youth representatives (1 from each region + 1 indigenous representative), was created 2004. The tasks of the council are: to strengthen the youth cooperation in the Barents region, to influence regional authorities in questions concerning youths and their future in the Barents region, to empower young people to actively participate in the shaping of the Barents region and the society in which they live.

The training course was held together with the annual meeting of BRYC. The BRYCers got some basic education in newspaper articles and press release writing, presentation techniques, public speaking, radio interviewing, as well as project management and team building.

**Place and date:** Murmansk (Russia), 21-25 March

**Participants:** Sweden (2), Norway (3), Finland (3), Russia (5), (1)-indigenous people

**Contact:** Norwegian Barents Secretariat, BYCO

**Financing:** Norwegian Barents Secretariat (80 000 NOK), regional financing.

**BYCO's involvement:** large: practical arrangement and organizing the event, providing the content of the training course, counseling, cooperation with Russian regional authorities, transport and accommodation, participation in BRYC meetings, coordinating of activity.

**Duration of support:** January – March 2007.

**Result:** The course was appreciated by the BRYCers. BRYC is doing good job, the work goes on.

### **07/2007 Child care project *new!***

**Objective:** to exchange experiences and views on acute problems of child care and youth work.

**Sphere:** social

**Description:** experience exchange seminar for Russian and Norwegian youth workers on acute problems like school drop-outs, effects of alcohol and drugs on children, child care in specialized institutions, etc.

**Place and date:** 4-11 Mai 2007 Trondheim (Norway)

**Participants:** Russia + Norway = 50 participants

**Organizer:** Norwegian union of children and youth workers, Murmansk Regional Trade Union

**Financing:** Norwegian union of children and youth workers

**BYCO's involvement:** small: counseling, establishing contacts with the Russian partner, practical assistance and coordination of activity.

**Duration of support:** March – April 2007.

**Result:** The project has been successfully carried out, the partners agreed to continue cooperation in the future.

### **08/2007 Fenology of the Northern Calotte 2007 *new!***

**Objective:** to attract youths to study environmental issues, observe nature.

**Sphere:** environment, education

**Description:** a 3-day seminar for school children interested in environmental issues and ecology, participants learned about nature of the region, made water and soil analyses, observed plants and animals of the region. Teachers exchanged experiences of teaching nature related subjects and making children interested in them.

**Place and date:** 9-11 Mai 2007 Murmansk (Russia)

**Participants:** Russia + Norway = 60 participants

**Organizer:** School N1 (Murmashi), schools of Apatity, Kandalaksha (Russia, Murmansk region), shools of Alta, Vardø and Vadsø (Norway)

**Financing:** Ministry of environment of Norway, own contributions of the participants.

**BYCO's involvement:** small: counseling, establishing contacts with the Russian partner, practical assistance and coordination of activity.

**Duration of support:** April – Mai 2007.

**Result:** The project has been successfully carried out, the partners agreed to continue cooperation in the future.

### **09/2007 Youth Parliamentary Club *new!***

**Objective:** to exchange experiences of work of youth councils from different countries and regions

**Sphere:** NGO

**Description:** a 3-day seminar for members of youth councils from different regions and countries, with discussions concerning the role of youth councils and importance of their work, discussion of their common problems together with representatives of state structures.

**Place and date:** 15-18 May 2007, Petrozavodsk

**Participants:** Russia (Murmansk region, Republics of Komi and Karelia), Norway, Germany – total number 60 persons

**Organizer:** Committee for sport and youth affairs of the Republic of Karelia

**Financing:** Committee for sport and youth affairs of the Republic of Karelia

**BYCO's involvement:** spreading the information about the event, participation in the event, contact making work, spreading the information about BYCO, counseling.

**Duration of support:** April – Mai 2007.

**Result:** The project has been successfully carried out, the partners agreed to continue cooperation in the future

### **10/2007 Mathematics project *new!***

**Objective:** to attract youths to mathematics, to show the practical use of theory. .

**Sphere:** education

**Description:** the project has been organized in two parts. First Norwegian students came to Murmansk and studied theory for shooting a racket and measuring how high it would go. And second part of the project was when Russian students came to Norway and built and launched the racket, after that they calculated how high it went. They also had a opportunity to explore cultural and traditions of Norway and Russia.

**Place and date:** 26-29 March Murmansk (Russia), 28-31 Mai 2007 Vardø (Norway)

**Participants:** Russia + Norway = 30 participants

**Organizer:** Vardø videregående school, Murmansk professional college N6.

**Financing:** Norwegian Barents Secretariat, own financing of the organizers.

**BYCO's involvement:** medium: counseling, practical assistance (visas and papers) and coordination of activity.

**Duration of support:** April – Mai 2007.

**Result:** The project has been successfully carried out, the partners agreed to continue cooperation in the future.

### **11/2007 Business planning seminar** *new!*

**Objective:** to provide young entrepreneurs with information concerning business planning.

**Sphere:** entrepreneurship

**Description:** during the seminar the participants learned a lot about unusual and innovative ways of business development.

**Place and date:** 26-28 May Murmansk (Russia)

**Participants:** Russia + Sweden = 30 participants

**Organizer:** Murmansk state technical university, YE-group.

**Financing:** Norwegian Barents Secretariat

**BYCO's involvement:** small: counseling, participation in the seminar.

**Duration of support:** Mai 2007.
